

# Hygiene and safety rules for trade fairs and trade shows

In accordance with the measures of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic, the holding of trade fairs is allowed only in the system of proving immunity / infectivity O-N-T (vaccination - past illness - test) and according to subsequent extraordinary measures. Below are the rules set for exhibitors and trade fair visitors. The current version of the O-N-T system, including requirements for trade fairs, is listed on the website of the [Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic](#). The organizer of the event has the right and the obligation to check the persons, while compliance with the rules is the personal responsibility of each participant. The purpose of the measure is to ensure the safe participation of all persons.

## O-N-T certificate

The entry of exhibitors and visitors, including participants from abroad, is possible exclusively according to the current rules of the O-N-T system. Exhibitors will prove the required O-N-T compliance for the trade fair exposition staff by an affidavit (they will receive the form from the company Veletrhy Brno, a.s. before the start of the event), or a valid test.

Visitors will prove themselves upon entry with the appropriate document (vaccination certificate, valid PCR test not older than 7 days, POC test not older than 72 hours, certificate or SMS message confirming the illness in the period of 180 days). For logistical reasons, we recommend that unvaccinated persons obtain a valid test in advance. Alternatively, they can use the testing facility at the exhibition center.

Note: The O-N-T system also applies to BVV employees and other service personnel.

## Online services and ticketing

The most convenient way to order services for your exhibition stand in advance is the use of an [online order form](#). Similarly, it is more convenient to [purchase tickets online](#). At the cash registers, use contactless payment card.



### **Respiratory protection**

The exhibition halls have an above-standard clear height and modern air conditioning ensures the exchange of fresh air. However, the protection of the upper respiratory tract is governed by the valid measures of the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic for retail and indoor services.



### **Disinfection**

There are stands with disinfection in the entrance areas and other places of the exhibition halls. Meeting and conference rooms are being regularly disinfected.



### **Social distancing**

The fair ground premises, including passages, walkways and roads, are laid out in such a way that participants can keep sufficient distance. Avoiding the accumulation of people and keeping clearances is necessary especially for cash registers and turnstiles.



### **Refreshments according to the rules**

Catering in exhibition halls and stands is governed by the currently valid rules for restaurant facilities and/or shopping centers, ie sitting while eating without respiratory protection.



### **Cleaning frequency**

Higher frequency of cleaning is provided in exhibition halls, toilets and other facilities, including disinfection of places frequented by a larger number of people.
